Rules for Drivers and Junior (17 & Under) Drivers

Since our Horse Show rules do not address any Driving Rules, we have addressed a few safety rules for All Drivers. Normal Driving Rules will apply. Junior Drivers may enter all classes.

Safety Inspection:

All Drivers will be required to have a Safety Inspection before the show begins. We will have an experienced Inspector set up no later than 8am for you. This will be a learning experience and for the Safety of All of our participants and their animals. You will be asked to fix any Safety problems before the classes start. Depending upon the severity of any problem found and the ability to fix said problem, you may not be able to participate in the class. Final ruling will be by the Safety Inspector and the Show Manager. Remember, we are here to help you all show in a Safe Environment. So be early. Classes start at 8:30am

1. Hitching and Unhitching Rule: during the process of hitching and unhitching - ALL DRIVERS must adhere to following- The bridle must be on the horse with reins attached and thru the turrets while cart is being hitched and/or unhitched. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave show grounds and forfeiting any High Points.
2. A Junior Driver is 17 & Under as of December 1, 2010.
3. Junior Drivers must wear a Helmet
4. Additional dress regulations for all drivers are: hat, gloves, a long sleeve shirt or jacket
5. All Drivers must carry a whip.
6. A Safety Person must be on board with each Junior Driver with the following exception: Mini & Ponies Class - In only the M & P Class - due to small cart and deep sand - Junior Drivers must have a Safety Person available to them in the arena-they do not have to ride in the cart. At the time of the class, we will meet and discuss the best course of action for positioning of Safety Person.
7. For Safety Reasons we have changed the Driving Class Schedule:

<u>Classes:</u>	31: Pleasure Mini's	Open
	32: Pleasure Draft - 1500 lbs & Over	Open
	33: Pleasure Light Horses	Open
	34: Pleasure Ponies	Open
	35: Pleasure Mules & Donkeys	Open
	36: Cones-Open to all Breeds-timed	Open
