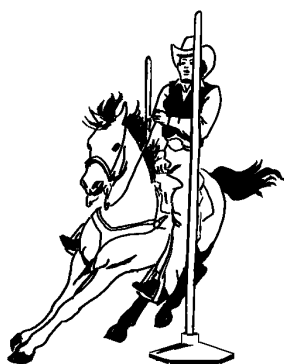
COMMITTEES REPORTS

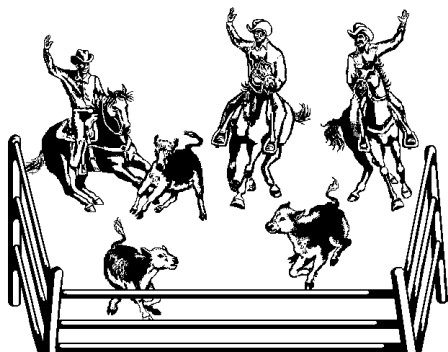
and cook shack. We are so thankful to you all for coming out and supporting the club. Without your help we wouldn't be able to have these events.

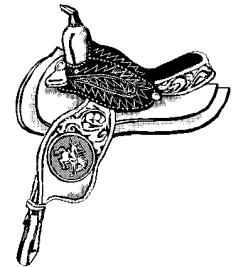
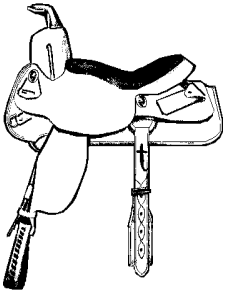
